Students who attend school regularly do better in school, have more friends, require less discipline and are more comfortable. Please call the office before 8:30 am, 676-6440 when possible, if your child will be absent or late to school.

Absences must be excused within 2 days. District policy clearly states that after 5 unexcused absences the BECCA process will be put in motion. Please refer to the district website for additional information. You may call during school hours. Also, you may call before/after school hours and leave a message on our voicemail. School starts every morning at 8:30 am and students are marked absent once the bell has rung if they are not in their classroom. Students arriving after 8:30 must stop by the office to pick up a tardy slip for their teacher so that their absence can be changed to a tardy. Students are welcome to arrive at 8 am for supervised playground. Free breakfast for all students will be served in the classroom at 8:30 am.
